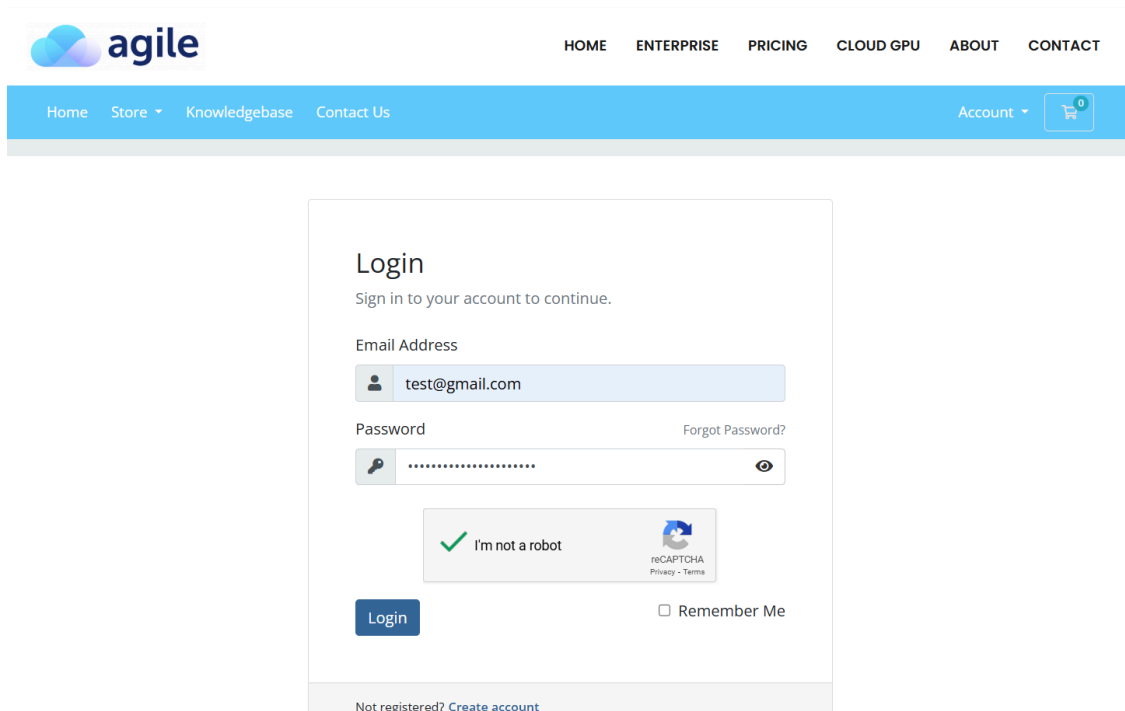


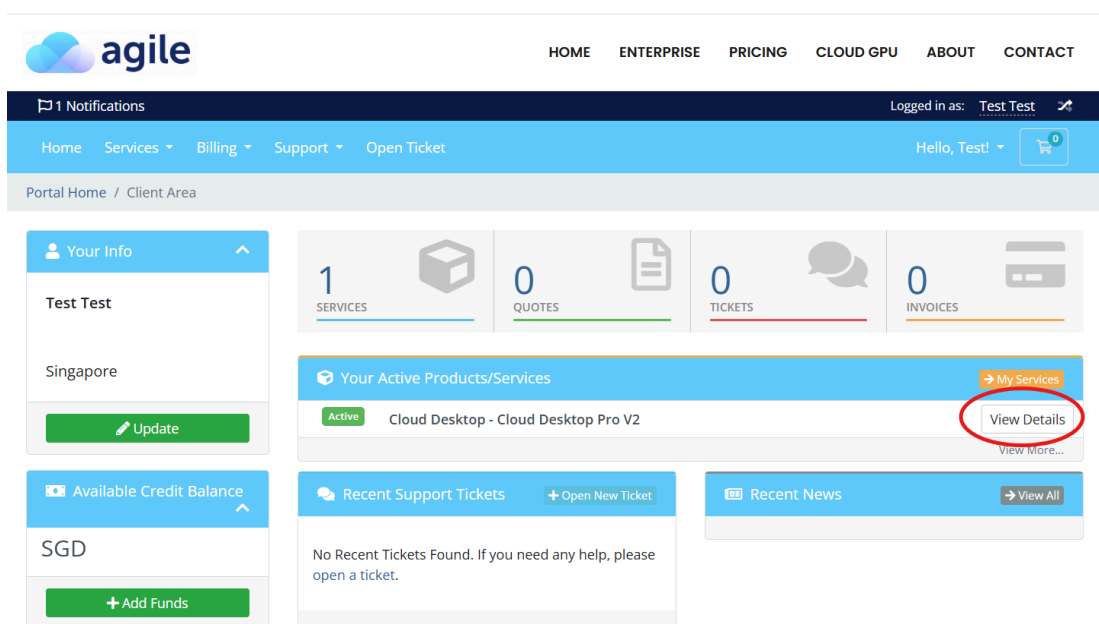
Agile Cloud Desktop Pro Step By Step Guide

1. Login to Agile Cloud Client area - <https://client.agile.sg/index.php?rp=/login>

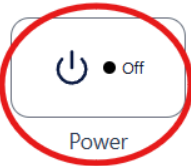
2. You will arrive at the Home page. Under Cloud Desktop Pro, click on **“View Details”**.

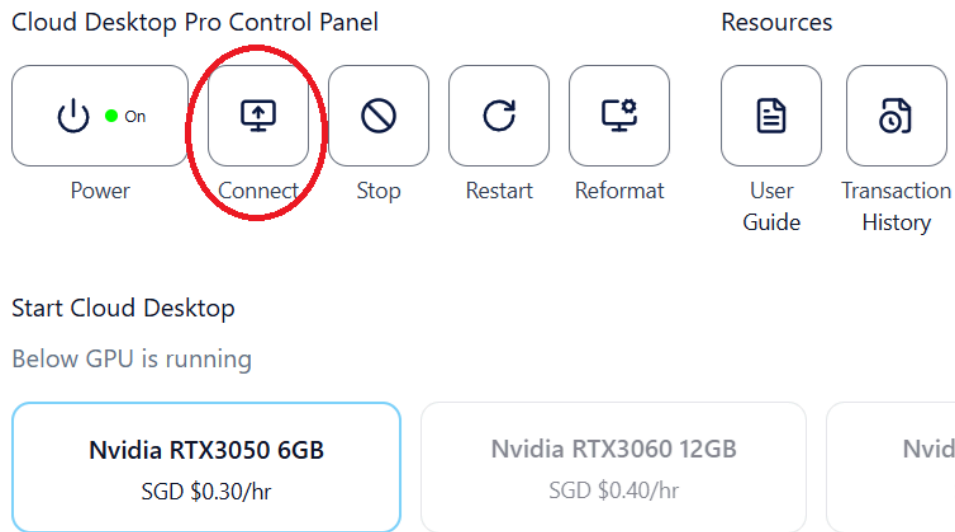
7. Launch the installer file and proceed to Install.



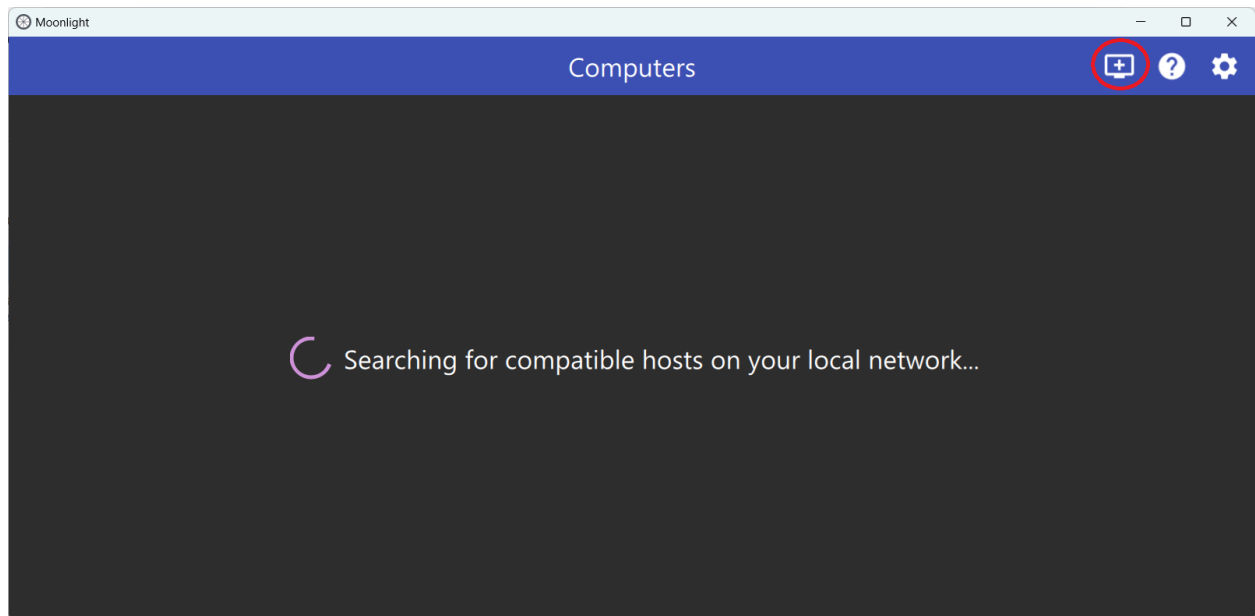
8. After installation is completed, launch Moonlight



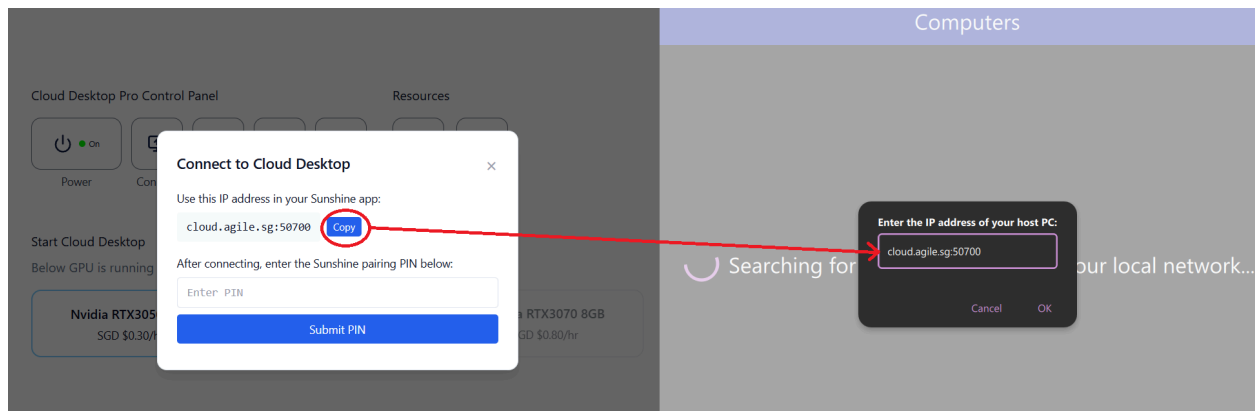
9. Return to the Cloud Desktop Pro Control Panel, click on “Connect”.



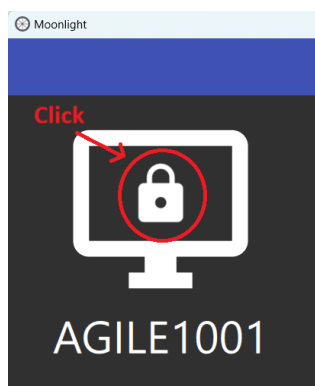
10. Go to Moonlight application. Click on "Add PC manually". It is an icon with a + sign.



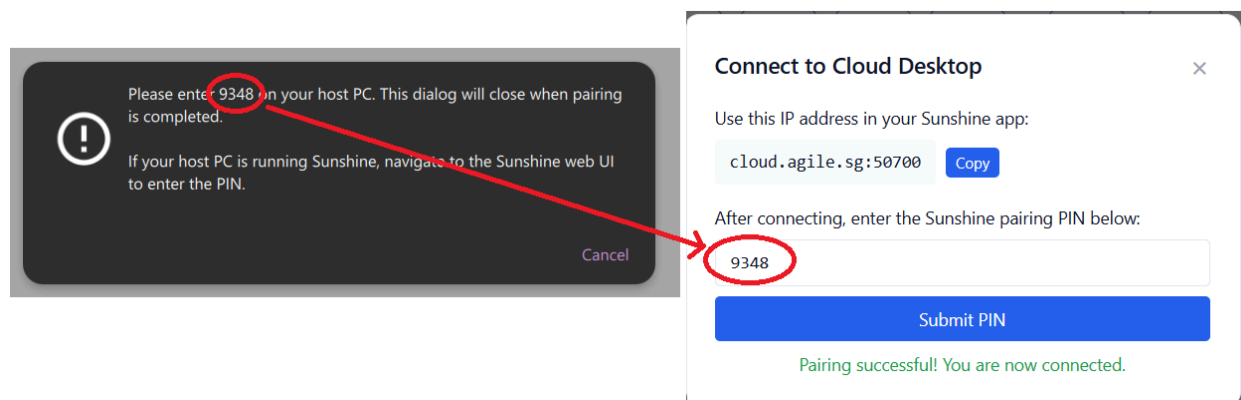
11. Copy the IP address provided and paste it in Moonlight. Click OK.



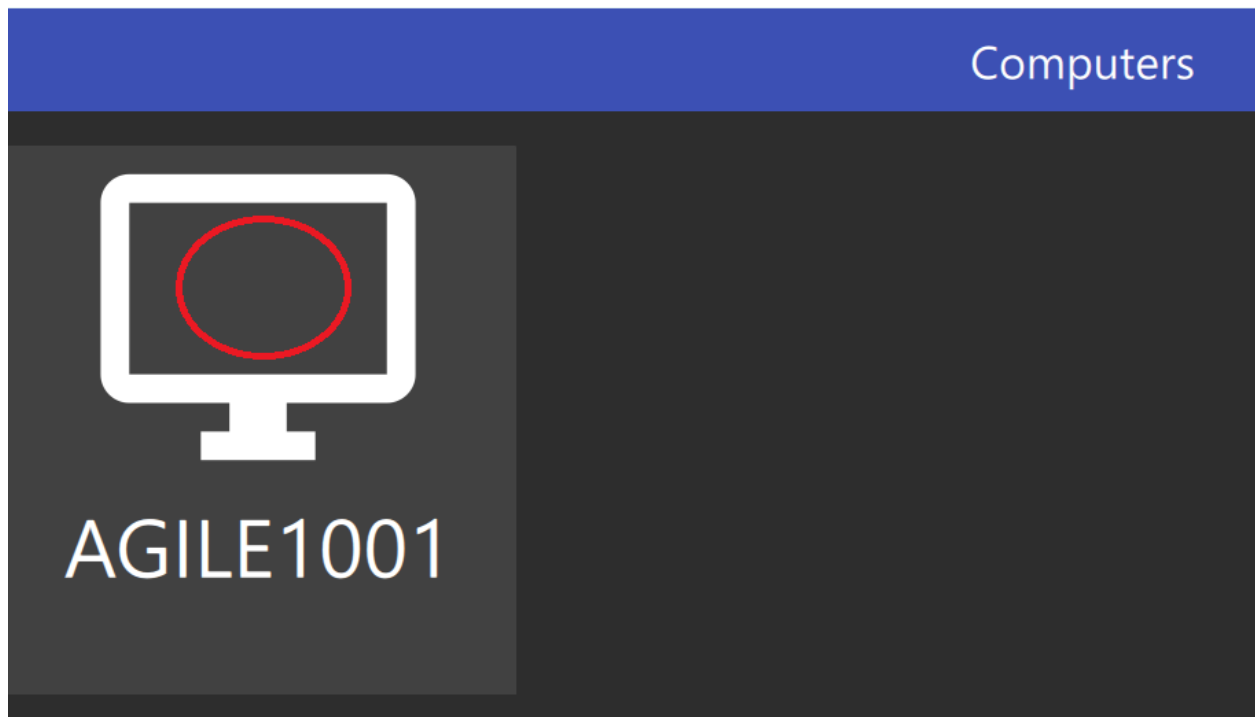
12. Your cloud desktop will appear in Moonlight but with a padlock icon. Click on the cloud desktop.



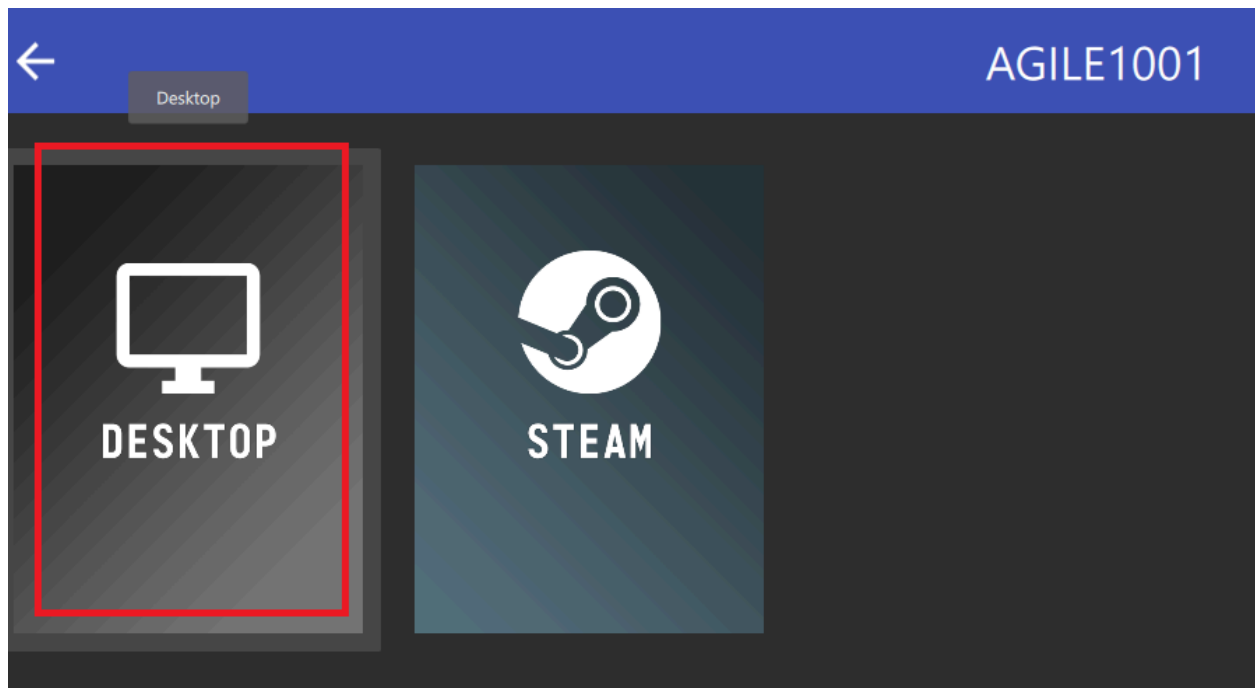
13. A pin code will be provided, enter it in the Cloud Desktop Pro Control Panel and click Submit PIN.



14. The padlock icon will disappear from your cloud desktop and you may now proceed to launch your cloud desktop. Click on your cloud desktop to launch it.



15. Click on "Desktop" to continue launching your cloud desktop.



16. Login with the Windows password provided in the activation e-mail and enjoy your cloud desktop!
